In this letter to the church at Corinth, Paul sets in order God’s laws for righteous living. Because of the influence of a pagan society, Paul addresses a variety of problems in the life-style of the Corinthian church: immorality, questionable practices, abuses of the Lord’s Supper and spiritual gifts – just to name a few. In this class, we will learn God’s directions for righteous living and how to have loving relationships with everyone in the body of Christ.

Starting June 3rd, join Pastor Pat for the mid-week summer sanctuary service from 7:00-8:30 PM. Praise and worship will be led by Joe Gallo and the worship team. Your faith will be built up through the preaching and teaching of the Word of God. Times of special prayer will be offered.



Joining us on Wednesday evenings will be guest bible teacher Rev. Dave Siriano. He has dedicated much of his life studying Eschatology (The Study of End Time prophecy). You will learn how the Holy

Spirit speaks to the Nations of the World through prophecy as it pertains to current events, why we believe we are living in the last days, and much more.

Following brother Siriano will be Pastor Pat, he will be preaching a series of messages on *The Necessity of Prayer and The Importance of Waiting on the Lord*. The Bible passage: “*But the end of all things is at hand; therefore be serious and watchful in your prayers*” 1 Peter 4:7 will serve as his main text. In addition, he will be preaching a series on *the Person, Presence and Power of the Holy Spirit* in the believer’s life. You will learn how the Holy Spirit not only abides in us, but gives us strength to live out God’s Word, Witness and Endure to the End. Jesus concludes The Great Commission text with this wonderful promise: “*.... And lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age*” Matthew 28:18-20. He is with us through the Person, Presence and Power of the Holy Spirit.
