THE BOOK OF ACTS

The Holy Spirit Working Through The Church

Join Pastor Pat in the Spring Quarter (March, April, and May) for a life-changing study through The Book of Acts. Although we call this book “The Acts of the Apostles”, it is more accurately described as the *Acts of the Holy Spirit working through the Apostles*.

The Book of Acts is more than first-century history; it is a narrative about the Triune God on an unstoppable mission to the ends of the earth.

The core message of the New Testament is that the power of God changes lives, transforms points of view, and makes people new creations. God is waiting patiently, promising to connect us with the greatest source of power we will ever know – The Power of the Holy Spirit. Jesus promised His disciples; “*But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you...*” Acts 1:8a. Purely and simply, it is the power of God that manifests itself through fasting and prayer.

Each Wednesday night will be filled with a time of worship, teaching, and prayer for personal needs.

Pastor Pat is sensing the Lord’s leading to designate Wednesday’s starting in the Spring Quarter as a day set aside for fasting and prayer. In Scripture there is a powerful interaction between fasting and prayer. Fasting detaches us from the flesh; while prayer attaches us to God. These two spiritual disciplines were faithfully exercised in the early church – the results were astounding!
